Mission 'GLO'

Since last September, when it was announced to us that the organization that was originally charged by St. John, the capital supporter for The Angel Dormitory, no longer wished to be involved with the project nor remain at all in Cambodia, we have been praying on knowing God's will for us. We believe that God has created for us a special privilege and chose us to have a special relationship with the Cambodian church.

Cambodia is, according to the American Bible Society, now the fastest growing mission field in the world. It is at a point today where China was 15 years ago. But, Cambodia is also one of the poorest countries in the world with an average family income of about \$600 a year (this used to be just \$300 a year). Our previous sending organization set a precedent that as missionaries, we spend part of our time developing partners and supporters to provide the approximately \$4000 each month to keep us in the field.

Originally, we thought we would need to register as a 501C3, but God provided an alternative in the form of Global Lutheran Outreach (GLO). GLO is a 501C3 tax exempt organization that helps us with budgeting, record keeping, insurance, and travel arrangements. It supports a total of eight mission couples including us in South

America, Africa, and now Asia. We will be GLO's first missionaries in Asia as it continues to grow and help more and more of us fulfill the Great Commission.

We praise God for Rev. Jim Tino and GLO!

In Partnership with the ELCC

As we joined GLO, we had to adapt to some new policies. One of these is that we needed to come up with a plan to better involve the local church. During our previous time in Cambodia, we met and developed a relationship with Pastor C. Vannarith, the President of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Cambodia. As a result of our relationship, Pastor Vannarith has written a formal invitation for us to return to Cambodia and work with ELCC on community development including The Angel Dormitory.

Currently, we meet with Pastor Vannarith on Skype approximately two to three times a month. Every conversation reiterates his invitation and desire for us to hurry back.
